### **Neighborhood Signs**

Banners for Tower Grove East, The Gate District, Fox Park and Lafayette Square. Designs will be approved by neighborhood residents.

**Cost: \$40,000**

### **New Landscaping & Planters**

Beautify the 6th ward by investing in new planters and plants to be placed in cul-de-sacs and end-caps where neighborhood streets end along Jefferson Ave.

**Cost:\$60,000**

### **Trash Cans**

Place 10-20 new trash cans with an optional dog waste bag dispenser in high traffic areas within the ward. Locations will include major intersections, bus stops and other high pedestrian traffic areas.

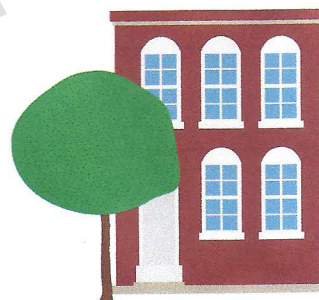

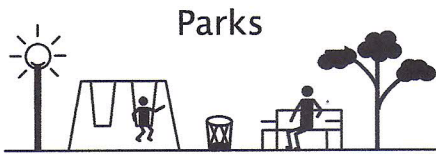

## Parks

- Eads Park Improvements**  
Install new park benches and low maintenance outdoor fitness stations.  
**Cost:\$20,000**
  
- Fox Park Restroom Renovation**  
The restrooms in Fox Park will be renovated and made ADA compliant for the benefit of the whole community.  
**Cost: \$30,000**
  
- Perk Up Buder Park**  
Add a child friendly/ ADA compliant drinking fountain.  
  
Paint 5 wooden benches  
  
Repair existing fence.  
**Cost: \$15,000**
  
- Decorative Bike Racks**  
Installation of approximately 10 bike racks around the ward with an emphasis on the 4 neighborhood parks.  
**Cost: \$17,000**



## Streets

- Crosswalk Light Jefferson and Park**  
Install an electric cross walk light across Jefferson at Park, which will allow pedestrians from Peabody and Lafayette Square to safely cross Jefferson to the Gate District and Save-A-Lot shopping area.  
**Cost: \$25,000**
  
- Bike Lanes**  
Allocate funds for the placement of bike 10 miles of bike lanes in the ward, with a primary interest on Jefferson; other locations possible.  
**Cost:\$30,000**
  
- Median At Jefferson and Park**  
Installing of a median at Jefferson and Park will not only beautify the street, but will also provide much needed traffic calming at that intersection in between The Barr Branch Library and the gas station .  
**Cost:\$80,000**



## Safety

- Traffic Calming on Compton**  
Speeding and running stop signs on Compton continues to be a significant safety concern.  
  
The 6th ward will commission a traffic study to determine the best way to calm traffic on Compton Ave  
**COST: \$50,000**
  
- Street Lighting**  
Good neighborhood lighting brings down crime and beautifies an area.  
  
The 6th ward will set aside money from the budget to enhance street lighting where it is most needed in the ward.  
**Cost: \$50,000**
  
- Security Cameras**  
Install of mobile security cameras which can be remotely monitored via the internet and can be relocated anywhere throughout the ward as security needs change.  
**Cost: \$30,000**
